Life and Death

* A few facts about life and death may be helpful to us.

Spiritual Death is the parent of physical death. There was no physical death until Adam died spiritually.

There was no death in the original blueprints of Creation. We know that at the end of this age, death will be swallowed up of Immortality.

1 Corinthians 15:26, "The last enemy that shall be abolished is death."
