## MADE WELL IN CHRIST

**[part 4 of 6]**

\* Hebrews 9:26, "But now once at the end of the ages hath He been manifested to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself."

Hebrews 10:12, "But He, when He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down on the right hand of God."

He put sin away that we might be Born Again, become New Creations, that the sin nature which had held us in bondage to the adversary should be eradicated and that the nature of God should take its place.

It is the New Nature that settles the sin problem for us individually.

The problem of sins is settled. The things we did before we accepted Christ are wiped out as though they had never been.

Now we are in the Family. We are the Righteousness of God in Him.

Hebrews 10:38, "But my righteous one shall live by faith: And if he shrink back, my soul hath no pleasure in him."

The New Creation is called the Righteousness of God. He is the Righteousness of God.

His standing with the Father is just like Jesus' standing. But if he sins, he has an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the Righteous.

He loses the sense of Righteousness when he sins, but Jesus, the Righteous One, intercedes for him and restores his lost fellowship and sense of Righteousness.
