## WHAT GOD SAYS ABOUT US

## [part 2 of 4]

\* God has no pleasure in lack, poverty, or want. Because of that, I can say, "My every need is supplied. I am blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenlies in Christ—not a Christ who is diminished and weakened and stripped of authority and ability, but the Christ who arose from the dead. And the very power that raised Him from the dead is resident in my body."
