* FAITH never rises above its confession. (We do not refer to the confession of sin, but the confession of the Word.)

If we confess weakness and failure and sickness, we destroy faith.

When we boldly make our confession that our diseases were laid on Jesus and we hold fast to that confession, we bring God on the scene.

Sometimes lack of knowledge will hinder us from making a bold confession.

We do not act on the Word beyond our knowledge.

Faith grows with understanding of the Word. Lack of knowledge of our Redemption and of our redemptive rights is oftentimes the reason for unbelief.
