Jesus Knew Who He Was

* Nearly every miracle that Jesus performed was performed with the Father's Words in Jesus' lips.

Jesus was the revealed will of the Father.

John 4:34 "My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to accomplish his work."

John 5:30 "I seek not mine own will, but the will of him that sent me."

John 6:38 "I am come down from heaven, not !n do mine own will, but the will of him that sent rue."

John 8:29 "For I do always the things that are pleasing to him."

What a picture of the Master! He had no personal ambitions, no personal ends to achieve. He was simply doing the will of His Father, unveiling the Father until He could say, "He that hath seen me bath seen the Father." (John 14:9)

The less worldly ambitions we have, the less worldly desires, the more fully the Father will unveil Himself to us.

His Words in our lips will perform the same prodigies that His Words performed in Jesus' lips.

Self-seeking limits one. The selfish man is a limited man. He who lives in the Word and lets the Word live in him, he who practices the Word and acts upon it, is the one who reveals the Father.

When we act upon the Word of God we unveil the Father.
