I AM WHAT GOD SAYS I AM

* You have received God's overflowing Grace and the gift of righteousness. That enables you to reign as a king in the realm of life through Jesus Christ. What would that conception of Christianity do for the millions of earnest men and women who are struggling to get faith and to get wisdom so that they may walk well pleasing in His sight

They have no knowledge of the Word. This is a revelation of the grace of God to us who are in the Body of Christ. Let us notice further Phil. 4:13.

One translator says:

"I have strength for anything." God is my ability; He is my wisdom; He is my righteousness; He is my perfect redemption from weakness, fear, and lack. I stand complete in Him, a victor over all my enemies.

I think the 20th Century Translation of Philippians 4:11 fits here "I have learned in whatsoever state I am, therein to be independent of circumstances.

"I know what it means to live on short rations; I know what it means to have an abundance. In all things, in every place, He is leading me in triumph in Christ."

2 Corinthians 2:14 is true:

"Thanks be unto God who always leads me in triumph in every place."

He is making Paul a victor, a conqueror, an overcomer; and is enabling him

to write this revelation, most of it behind prison bars. Paul was the spiritual conqueror of the ages; and what Paul was in Christ you are in Christ.
