MANY WILL BEGIN TO WALK AND LIVE OUT OF THEIR INNER MAN [SPIRIT]

....*put on the new man [give the recreated spirit a place of prominence], which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him".... Colossians 3:10 NASB*

In this hour, many children of God will begin to diligently "put on the new man" and begin to walk and live out of their inner man [*spirit*] from the place of great clarity and power [*one with the Holy Spirit*]. Over the coming weeks I will be addressing [*through the various writings*] any potential hindrances as well as those things that will expedite one's entrance into this glorious "new era" that is, even now, beginning to overtake us, in the remnant Church.

One of those things that have kept numerous children of God from breakthrough into the fullness that the Father has for them is "unforgiveness" [*in some form: bitterness, offense, resentment etc.*] - something that each and every one of us must be completely free from if we are to both enter into and fulfil our precious Kingdom-position and destiny, in Christ.

APPROPRIATING, BY FAITH, THE GRACE TO FORGIVE IS THE ONLY WAY FOR ONE TO RISE ABOVE THE BONDAGE OF UNFORGIVENESS

Quite simply, appropriating, by faith, the Grace [*divine Ability*] to forgive is the ONLY way for one to rise

above the bondage of unforgiveness - as it is ONLY divine Love [*and the Grace that is its spontaneous fruit*] that can empower us to forgive.

One may have a "good intention" to forgive - and, for a time, it may appear that there is a release from whatever caused them to enter into unforgiveness - but, in reality, forgiving in one's own strength is just another way to "sweep things under the carpet" so to speak - and, thus, somewhere down the line when the person that has done wrong does it again or even someone else in their sphere of existence does something similar THEN all of the "feelings" [*and resentments*] will rise to the surface once again.

When we make the "quality decision" to forgive [*even though it may seem an impossible task at first*] the Heavenly Father is not expecting us to do anything but believe in His Word - and through the accessing of His Grace [*which is encompassed in the totality of Jesus - Who is the Word of God*] - again, through a simple faith and trust in Him - allow Him to supernaturally empower us to "rise above" the things which seem impossible to us, such as forgiving those who have transgressed against us - or against those we love.

Without question, the importance of forgiving and the great danger of one holding to unforgiveness is something that each and every one of us needs to gain a deep revelation of.

....*"The things impossible with men are possible with God".... Luke 18:27 Young's Literal Translation*

....*"Lean on, trust in, and be confident in the Lord with all your heart and mind and do not rely on your own insight or understanding [sense-knowledge and perception]. In all your ways know, recognize, and acknowledge Him [through the continual accessing of His Grace], and He [the Spirit of Grace] will direct and make straight and plain your paths".... Proverbs 3:5-6 The Amplified Translation*

WE MUST BE THOSE WHO REFUSE TO HOLD TO UNFORGIVENESS IN ANY OF ITS FORMS

....*"Then Peter came and said to Him, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me and I forgive him?"*

Up to seven times?" Jesus *said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven. For this reason the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his slaves. When he had begun to settle them, one who owed him ten thousand talents was brought to him. But since he did not have the means to repay, his lord commanded him to be sold, along with his wife and children and all that he had, and repayment to be made. So the slave fell to the ground and prostrated himself before him, saying, 'Have patience with me and I will repay you everything.' And the lord of that slave felt compassion and released him and forgave him the debt. But that slave went out and found one of his fellow slaves who owed him a hundred denarii; and he seized him and began to choke him, saying, 'Pay back what you owe.' So his fellow slave fell to the ground and began to plead with him, saying, 'Have patience with me and I will repay you.' But he was unwilling and went and threw him in prison until he should pay back what was owed. So when his fellow slaves saw what had happened, they were deeply grieved and came and reported to their lord all that had happened. Then summoning him, his lord *said to him, 'You wicked slave, I forgave you all that debt because you pleaded with me. 'Should you not also have had mercy on your fellow slave, in the same way that I had mercy on you?' And his lord, moved with anger, handed him over to the torturers until he should repay all that was owed him. My heavenly Father will also do the same to you, if each of you does not forgive his brother from [the faith and Love that is in] your heart'.... Matthew 18:21-35 NASB

The parable above that Jesus taught is one of my very favourite ones because when one gains a revelation of the spiritual reality behind what He was saying they will be found not only refusing to hold to ANY unforgiveness [regardless of what one has done to them] they will enter into [and come to abide in] a place of freedom through the forgiveness of their own sins [and, thus, a clear knowledge {revelation} of who they truly are, in Christ]. This leads directly to a life that is truly free from any attempt by the Enemy to blind them and keep them in a place far below their precious destiny, in Christ.

One of the negative fruit of "unforgiveness" is that it blocks one from gaining a revelation of the Father's Love - because faith [which is both activated and energized by Love] will not work [function properly] AT ALL in an unforgiving heart.

It is certain that "holding to" unforgiveness in ANY of its forms [offense, resentment, bitterness] condemns [and, thus, defiles] one's own heart [spirit] and "negates" [quenches] the flow [capability] of faith in their prayers -

as well as the flow of God's Life and healing power into their being [spirit, soul and body].

"negate" - to deny the existence, evidence or truth of; to nullify or cause to be ineffective;

"quench" - to put out or extinguish; suppress;

...."A joyful heart is good medicine [causes good healing], But a broken [wounded, defiled] spirit dries up the bones".... Proverbs 17:22 NASB

...."A calm and undisturbed mind and heart are the life and health of the body, but envy, jealousy, and wrath are like rottenness of the bones".... Proverbs 14:30 The Amplified Translation

some key scriptures:

...."having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, [by] perfecting holiness in the fear [reverence] of God [thus allowing Him to expel {displace} every last ground of fear {unrighteousness}]".... 2 Corinthians 7:1 NASB

...."And Jesus answered saying to them, "Have faith in God". [lit. have the faith of God] "Truly I say to you, whoever SAYS to this mountain [obstacle, problem, infirmity etc.], 'Be taken up and cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes [affirms on an ongoing basis] that what he says is going to happen, it will be [granted] him. Therefore I say to you, all things for which you pray and ask, believe [based on the finished work of the Cross, the Word of God and the Blood Covenant] that you have [already] received them, and they will be [granted] you".... ...."if you forgive people their trespasses [their reckless and willful sins, leaving them, letting them go, and giving up resentment], your heavenly Father will also [be enabled to] forgive you. But if you do not forgive others their trespasses [their reckless and willful sins, leaving them, letting them go, and giving up resentment], neither will your Father [be enabled to] forgive you your trespasses".... Matthew 6:14-15 The Amplified Translation

HATRED OPENS THE DOOR TO ALL MANNER OF EVIL IN ONE'S LIFE

When one "holds to" [maintains] unforgiveness [to any degree] THEN they become "susceptible" to the Enemy's attempts to lure them into taking offense [at even the smallest of things] - which then, in turn, "fuels" [builds

upon] the "resentment and bitterness" that are designed by the Enemy to protect the "root" [stronghold] of unforgiveness that he has established in that one's heart and mind. "Hatred" [offense, bitterness, unforgiveness] opens the door to all manner of evil [curses] entering into the life of the one who "maintains" an offense.

"susceptible" - accessible or especially liable or subject to some influence; yielding readily to; liable to be afflicted by;

....*"Strive to live in peace with everybody and pursue that consecration and holiness without which no one will [ever] see the Lord. Exercise foresight and be on the watch to look [after one another], to see that no one falls back from and fails to secure God's Grace [His unmerited favor and spiritual blessing], in order that no root of resentment [rancor, bitterness, or hatred] shoots forth and causes trouble and bitter torment, and the many become contaminated and defiled by it".... Hebrews 12:14-15 The Amplified Translation*

Forgiveness is an act of one's will and, also, an act of faith - which is activated and energized by the Love of God, alone. In other words, when one make a quality decision of the heart to be free from unforgiveness in any of its forms there is nothing the Enemy can do about it - and, ultimately, that one will experience perfect liberty where previously there has been great torment.

"quality decision" - a decision of the heart from which there is NO turning back;

....*"if we walk in the Light [a revelation of the Truth] as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son [continually] cleanses us from all sin".... 1 John 1:7 NASB*

THE IMPORTANCE OF CONFESSING LOVE AND FORGIVENESS

As mentioned previously, forgiveness, some times more than others [depending on the "history" {duration} of the transgression against one] becomes a "sheer" [unqualified, utter] act of the will on our part. Many times, at first, it is extremely difficult for one to overcome in the area of forgiving [especially if the transgressor and/or transgression continues to "stare one in the face"] BUT, in their CONTINUAL accessing of His Grace, the Father will SURELY bring through, perfectly, the one that is faithful to pursue forgiveness with ALL of their heart.

In the midst of the "turmoil" [especially emotional]

that surely ensues when one is transgressed against the task then becomes for that one to continue to confess [proclaim out loud any time a thought of unforgiveness or a "flinch" of heart occurs] love and forgiveness over those ones who have transgressed against them upon EVERY "remembrance" of their name [or the situation]. For it is certain that the Enemy continually attempts to catch one off guard [especially when they are still "potentially" vulnerable] with a view to provoking them to speak or act in a "spirit of self-righteousness" or self-vindication [not to mention "revenge"].

As one is faithful to do this [regardless of how they may "feel" towards another at the time] THEN, ultimately, they will reach the state of being totally "unmoved" [influenced] by anyone or anything that has caused pain in the past.

One must ALWAYS remember that they have [as children of God] the power abiding within their heart [they are anointed to do ALL things though Christ by the Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of Love!] to break "impasses" [in this case, a stronghold of unforgiveness or bitterness and resentment] by continually proclaiming [speaking out loud] what is in their heart "in abundance" UNTIL they [the impasses or strongholds] are blown apart by the power of Love.

And, regardless of whether or not those who have transgressed against them have repented [asked for forgiveness] or not, they [the transgressors] will be released "fully" into the hands of the Father - while those who have chosen the way of forgiveness above all else will enter fully into "perfect liberty" [of heart] concerning the entire situation.

....*"[Now having received the Holy Spirit {Who is the Spirit of Love}, and being led and directed by Him] if you forgive the sins of anyone, they are forgiven [released]; if you retain the sins of anyone, they [the effects of that sin] are retained [both in your life and in their life]".... John 20:23 The Amplified Translation*

....*"So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience; bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you. Beyond all these things put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity".... Colossians 3:12-14 NASB*

The importance of freedom from ALL unforgiveness is a topic that is very close to my heart because one gaining

a revelation of these things is a certain catalyst to the perfect liberty that the Heavenly Father desires each and every one of us to walk in - far above the place of fear, torment and bondage that the Enemy attempts to keep us chained with.

Always remember:

All that matters is one stepping into the fullness their perfect liberty in Christ. It has already been paid for.

....*"I sought the LORD, and He answered me, and delivered me [past tense] from ALL my fears. They looked to Him and were radiant, and their faces will NEVER be ashamed".... Psalms 34:4-5 NASB*

....*"There is no fear in love [dread does not exist], but full-grown (complete, perfect) [revelation of] love turns fear out of doors and EXPELS [displaces] every trace of terror!".... 1 John 4:18 The Amplified Translation*

....*"And He [the Father] raised us up [past tense] together with Him and made us sit down together [giving us joint seating with Him] in the heavenly sphere [by virtue of our being] in Christ Jesus [the Messiah, the Anointed One]".... Ephesians 2:6 The Amplified Translation*

....*"[The Father] has delivered [past tense] and drawn us to Himself out of the control and the dominion of darkness and has transferred us [past tense] into the kingdom of the Son of His love".... Colossians 1:13 The Amplified Translation*

....*"But by His [the Father's] doing you are IN Christ Jesus, Who became to us [past tense] wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption".... 1 Corinthians 1:30 NASB*

THE FIRST AND FOREMOST PRIORITY OF EVERY CHILD OF GOD SHOULD BE TO GIVE THE WORD OF GOD PREMINENCE IN ALL THINGS

In this time, where we find ourselves on "the threshold of breakthrough", it is very important to revisit the basic principles of life in the Kingdom. The first and foremost priority of EVERY child of God should be to make sure that they are giving the Word of God preminence in their lives - day in and day out. For in giving the Word preminence one's spirit [inner man] will be constantly fed to the point of "overflowing".

....*"The entrance and unfolding of Your words [into*

one's heart {spirit}] give light [revelation]; their unfolding gives understanding [discernment and comprehension]".... Psalms 119:130 The Amplified Translation

WHEN THE MOUTH SPEAKS, THE MIND HAS TO STOP AND LISTEN TO WHAT IT IS SAYING

Speaking words in alignment with a "revelation" of God's Word out loud [at least loud enough for us to hear it] - is so important. I have said it before and I will say it again,

"WHEN THE MOUTH SPEAKS, THE MIND HAS TO STOP AND LISTEN TO WHAT IT IS SAYING".

Therefore, speaking or proclaiming the Word of God causes the "lying thoughts" of the Enemy [that is ANY thought that attempts to exalt itself above a revelation of the Father's Word/Will] to "dissipate" and, when one is consistent in their confession [proclamation] then, very soon, those thoughts the Enemy attempts to "inundate" [bombard] one's mind with will not only be driven out [expelled] they will not gain entrance at all. These things are the key to not only the renewal of the mind but, also, entrance into the place wherein one is found "abiding" in the Mind of Christ.

"dissipate" - to scatter in various directions; disperse; dispel; disappear;

....*"be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect".... Romans 12:1-2 NASB*

....*"we have the mind of Christ [the Messiah] and do hold the thoughts [feelings and purposes] of His heart".... 1 Corinthians 2:16b The Amplified Translation*

a word from the Father:

* One's tongue, if not "guarded" [by a "superabundance" of My Word in their heart], opens the door for the Enemy to perpetuate his vile schemes - while the diligent guarding of the tongue - through meditating on My Word day and night [which empowers one to continually bring EVERY thought captive to a "revelation" of My Word/Will] puts him to flight.

....*"out of the fullness [the overflow, the superabundance] of the heart the mouth speaks".... Matthew 12:34 The Amplified Translation*

....*"Death and life are in the power of the tongue"....*

....*"We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the true knowledge of God [and who we ALREADY are, in Christ], and we are taking every thought captive [through proclamation] to the obedience of Christ [a revelation of the Father's Will]".... 2 Corinthians 10:5 NASB*

DIVINE FAVOR

If Satan can successfully distract one in their "thoughts" and "speech" - through causing them to focus on the negative [*temporal realm*] - it will definitely hinder the flow of the Father's favor and Goodness in their lives until such a time as they consistently are found bringing EVERY thought captive to a revelation of God's Word/Will. Therefore, it is of the utmost importance that we are found faithful in even the smallest details of our lives to give thanks as well as acknowledge the favor of God upon our lives - at EVERY turn.

a word from the Father:

* The Blessing [*of Abraham*] on the lives of My children is the divine empowerment to prosper in every aspect of life and ministry. My divine Favour on the lives of My children continually produces the opportunity [*circumstance*] to make it happen.

"the "Blessing" - is the empowerment [*of the Word and the Holy Spirit*] to prosper, to succeed, to increase, to multiply, to excel, to rise above everything that attempts to hold one back or keep them down as they walk out the course that the Father prepared for them from before the foundations of the earth.

....*"The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it".... Proverbs 10:22 KJV*

....*"The LORD shall command the blessing upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto; and he shall bless thee in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee".... Deuteronomy 28:8 NASB*

....*"For whoever finds me [Wisdom] finds life and draws forth and obtains favor from the Lord".... Proverbs 8:35 The Amplified Translation*

1. Supernatural increase and promotion;

7. Preferential treatment;
8. A granting of our petitions;
9. A change or reversal of policies, rules and law;
10. Avoidance of some battles, as God will fight them for us;

HOW TO KEEP YOURSELF FROM THE "WICKED ONE"

....*"We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God **keepeth himself**, and that wicked one toucheth [influences] him not".... 1 John 5:18 KJV*

1. Walk in Love.

....*"Love endures long and is patient and kind; love never is envious nor boils over with jealousy, is not boastful or vainglorious, does not display itself haughtily. It is not conceited (arrogant and inflated with pride); it is not rude (unmannerly) and does not act unbecomingly. Love (God's love in us) does not insist on its own rights or its own way, for it is not self-seeking; it is not touchy or fretful or resentful; it takes no account of the evil done to it [it pays no attention to a suffered wrong]. It does not rejoice at injustice and unrighteousness, but rejoices when right and truth prevail. Love bears up under anything and everything that comes, is ever ready to the best of every*

person, its hopes are fadeless under all circumstances, and it endures everything [without weakening]. Love never fails [never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end]".... 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 The Amplified Translation

2. Position yourself for your mind to be constantly renewed by the power of God's Word.

.... "And do not follow the customs of the present age, but be transformed by the entire renewal of your minds, so that you may learn by experience what God's will is--that will which is good and beautiful and perfect".... Romans 12:2 The Weymouth Translation

.... "I therefore beg of you, please, brethren, through the instrumentality of the aforementioned mercies of God, by a once-for-all presentation to place your bodies at the disposal of God, a sacrifice, a living one, a holy one, well-pleasing, your rational, sacred service. And **stop assuming an outward expression that does not come from within you and is not representative of what you are in your inner being** [spirit] but is patterned after this age; but change your outward expression to one that comes from within and is representative of your inner being, by the renewing of your mind, resulting in your putting to the test what is the will of God, the good and well-pleasing and complete will, and having found that it meets specifications, place your approval upon it".... Romans 12:1-2 The Wuest Translation

3. Let NO corrupt [unrighteous] speech proceed from your mouth.

.... "Let NO [not even one] unwholesome [unrighteously motivated, self-seeking] word proceed from your mouth, but ONLY such [a word] as is good for edification according to the need [of the moment] so that it will give [impart] Grace [Life, Love, Truth, Wisdom, Righteousness etc.] to those who hear [including oneself]".... Ephesians 4:29 NASB

4. Put on the whole armour of God - and keep it on, through a faith that is "continually activated" by a revelation of your authority and true Identity, in Christ.

.... "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having

done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God".... Ephesians 6:10-17 KJV

5. Continually put yourself in a position to hear the still, small voice of the Holy Spirit - and, when He speaks, obey IMMEDIATELY.

But he who looks carefully into the faultless law, the [law] of liberty, and is faithful to it and perseveres in looking into it, being not a heedless listener who forgets but an active doer [who obeys], he shall be blessed in his doing [his life of obedience]".... James 1:22-25 The Amplified Translation

MODERN PROVERBS FOR THE GLORIOUS CHURCH

"proverb" - a wise saying or precept; a short, memorable, and often highly condensed saying embodying, especially with bold imagery, some commonplace fact or experience [in this case, the absolute Truth of God's Word];

.... "Love [God's love in us] does not insist on its own rights or its own way, for it is not self-seeking; it is not touchy or fretful or resentful; it takes no account of the evil

* It is a "Throne-relationship" that the Father desires to have with each of His precious children.

* Moment by moment waiting [ministering unto the Father and His Word], and seeking from the position of a heart "wholly given" are the only means by which an "absolute" success in every spiritual endeavour is assured.

"He who has My commandments [gained a revelation of the Father's Will] and keeps [remembers, exalts, honors, magnifies, does] them is the one who loves Me; and he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and will disclose Myself to him "If anyone loves Me, he will keep [remember, exalt, honor, magnify, do] My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our abode [having living communion] with him" John 14:21, 23 NASB

* If one does not seek the "deep things" of the Kingdom then they shall not know [be able to discern] the "deep things" [schemes] of Satan - but, rather will be overwhelmed by them.

* The "accusations" which pour forth from the lips of many are the "clear" indication of what abides in their "own" heart.

* Travailing prayer is prevailing prayer.

* Walk by love and NOT by sight [sense knowledge and perception].

.... "for we walk by faith [in the reality of who Love {the Word of God} says we are, in Christ], not by sight ["sense knowledge - that which is "perceived" through the five physical senses]" 2 Corinthians 5:7 NASB
