[January 12th]

* Those that adhere to sense knowledge and perception as their final authority continually speak words that align themselves with that which they perceive through their natural senses And, thus, they continually "say" what they have [are experiencing {see, hear, think or feel}].

"sense knowledge" - that which is perceived by what one feels, hears, sees or thinks based on their outward circumstances; that which is perceived [and expressed] through the soul [mind, will, emotions] - apart from "revelation" [the Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of wisdom and revelation];

Faith aligns itself with a revelation of My Will *[Word]* - and, thus, continually speaks words that affirm the Spiritual Reality of ALL and WHO that they are in Christ.

"affirm" - to state or assert positively; maintain as true; to express agreement with or commitment to;

...."Behold, as for the proud one, his soul is not right [in right order - in submission to the spirit] within him; But the righteous will live by his faith [out of his spirit, inner man - through revelation and trust in God]".... Habakkuk 2:4 NASB

...."we walk by faith [in the reality of who Love {the Word of God} says we are, in Christ], not by sight ["sense knowledge - that which is "perceived" through the five physical senses]".... 2 Corinthians 5:7 NASB

...."But having the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I BELIEVED, THEREFORE I SPOKE," we also believe, therefore we also speak [proclaim]".... 2 Corinthians 4:13 NASB

...."Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our confession".... Hebrews 3:1 NASB

...."Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses]".... Hebrews 11:1 The Amplified Translation

...."Therefore, we consider and look not to the things that are seen [the lower reality - that which is real to the five physical senses] but to the things that are unseen [through faith in the higher Reality of God's Word]; for the things that are visible are temporal (brief and fleeting) [subject to change], but the things that are invisible are deathless and everlasting [Eternal]".... 2 Corinthians 4:18 The Amplified Translation
