

REFLECTIONS OF THE FATHER'S HEART

[Exhortations From The Father]

[January 22nd]

* Grace [*My divine Life and Presence*] "displaces". In other words, the "reception" [*appropriation*] of My Grace into one's inner being [*spirit*] will "displace" all that is apart from Me, therein.

"displace" - to take the place of; replace; supplant; the displacing in space of one mass by another [*in this case, the Glory [Love] of God {the Light and Power of God's Word} displacing all that which had been established by the Enemy {in darkness}*];

For the ongoing reception of My Grace into one's inner being [*spirit*] will SURELY produce a river [*torrents*] of Life, Light, Love and Wisdom that will "flood" the soul [*mind, will, emotions*] and "quicken" the physical body [*manifesting in divine healing and health*].

....*"He who believes in Me [who cleaves to and trusts in and relies on Me] as the Scripture has said, From his innermost being [spirit] shall flow [continuously] springs and rivers of living water".... John 7:38 The Amplified Translation*

....*"There is no fear in love [dread does not exist], but full-grown (complete, perfect) [a revelation of] love turns fear out of doors and EXPELS [displaces] every trace of terror!".... 1 John 4:18 The Amplified Translation*

....*"the love [Wisdom, Truth, Grace] of God [the Father] has been poured out within our hearts [spirit, inner man] through the Holy Spirit [the Spirit of Love] who was given to us".... Romans 5:5 NASB*

THEREFORE

....*"Watch over your heart [spirit] with ALL diligence, for from it flow the springs of life [the forces of the Kingdom {Grace, Faith, Love, Truth, Righteousness and Wisdom}]".... Proverbs 4:23-24 NASB*

"diligence" - constant and earnest effort to accomplish what is undertaken;

THEREFORE

...."having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, [by] perfecting holiness in the fear [reverence] of God [thus allowing Him to {through the precious Blood, the power of His Word and the Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of Grace} expel {displace} every last ground of fear {unrighteousness}]".... 2 Corinthians 7:1 NASB
