* Righteous words and actions "impart" Grace while unrighteous *[self-exaltive and self-serving actions]* words impart "disgrace" *[condemnation, shame, unworthiness]* - and indeed, in one way or another, work to present everything that My children have been redeemed from *[in Christ]* as "real" *[still active in their life]*.

"disgrace" - the condition of being out of favor; loss of favor, regard, or respect; the state of being dishonored, or covered with shame; dishonor; shame; that which brings dishonor; cause of shame or reproach; great discredit; an act of unkindness; a disfavor; to do disfavor to; to bring reproach or shame upon; to dishonor; to treat or cover with ignominy; to lower in estimation; to treat discourteously; to upbraid; to revile;

synonym: to degrade; humble; humiliate; abase; disparage; defame; dishonor; debase.
