## [February 22nd]

\* Self-exaltive words and actions "impart" [promote] a "spirit of disgrace".

"**impart**" - to bestow a share or portion of; to give, grant, or communicate; to allow another to partake in; to communicate the knowledge of; to make known; to show by words; to tell; to disclose *[in this case, to further the "lies" of the Enemy]*;

"**promote**" - to contribute to the growth, enlargement of; to forward; to further; to advance; to urge on or incite another, as to strife;

"disgrace" - the condition of being out of favor; loss of favor, regard, or respect; the state of being dishonored, or covered with shame; dishonor; shame; that which brings dishonor; cause of shame or reproach; great discredit; an act of unkindness; a disfavor; to do disfavor to; to bring reproach or shame upon; to dishonor; to treat or cover with ignominy; to lower in estimation; to treat discourteously; to upbraid; to revile;

**synonym:** to degrade; humble; humiliate; abase; disparage; defame; dishonor; debase.
