[February 24th]

* Before one can receive [appropriate] the fullness [unimpeded flow] of My Grace into their life they must "allow" Me to remove [displace] every last stronghold established by the "spirits of disgrace" [and the hierachy thereof: unworthiness, shame, etc.].

"disgrace" - the condition of being out of favor; loss of favor, regard, or respect; the state of being dishonored, or covered with shame; dishonor; shame; that which brings dishonor; cause of shame or reproach; great discredit; an act of unkindness; a disfavor; to do disfavor to; to bring reproach or shame upon; to dishonor; to treat or cover with ignominy; to lower in estimation; to treat discourteously; to upbraid; to revile;

synonym: to degrade; humble; humiliate; abase; disparage; defame; dishonor; debase.

"displace" - to take the place of; replace; supplant; the displacing in space of one mass by another [*in this case, the Glory* [Love] of God {the Light and Power of God's Word} displacing all that which had been established by the Enemy {in darkness}];

...."He who believes in Me [who cleaves to and trusts in and relies on Me] as the Scripture has said, From his innermost being [spirit] shall flow [continuously] springs and rivers of living water".... John 7:38 The Amplified Translation

...."There is no fear in love [dread does not exist], but full-grown (complete, perfect) [a revelation of] love turns fear out of doors and EXPELS [displaces] every trace of terror!".... 1 John 4:18 The Amplified Translation

...."the love [Wisdom, Truth, Grace] of God [the Father] has been poured out within our hearts [spirit, inner man] through the Holy Spirit [the Spirit of Love, the Spirit of Grace etc.] who was given to us".... Romans 5:5 NASB

THEREFORE

...."Watch over your heart [spirit] with ALL diligence, for from it flow the springs of life [the forces of the Kingdom {Grace, Faith, Love, Truth, Righteousness and Wisdom}]".... Proverbs 4:23-24 NASB

"diligence" - constant and earnest effort to accomplish what is undertaken;

AND

...."having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, [by] perfecting holiness in the fear [reverence] of God [thus allowing Him to {through the precious Blood, the power of His Word and the Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of Grace} expel {displace} every last ground of fear {unrighteousness}]".... 2 Corinthians 7:1 NASB
