"UNTRUSTWORTHY"

Words of prophecy:

* One of the main reasons that one is found "untrustworthy" is because they still "maintain" a fear of man within their heart. It is ONLY a perfect [all-consuming] reverence of Me [My Will - Word] that brings one into the place of abiding in "trustworthiness" - both in My sight and in the sight of all those who truly love Me.

...."For am I now seeking the favor of men, or of God? Or am I striving to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a bond-servant of Christ".... Galatians 1:10 NASB

"untrustworthy" - not deserving of trust or confidence; not dependable; not reliable;

Anywhere there is pride and/or fear "held to" [wilfully maintained through rebellion] in one's life then they will be found to be "untrustworthy" because "self-will" remains on the throne of their heart. The only way that one can be found trustworthy is through a heart that is "wholly given" [by faith - and continually] to the Father and His Word in every aspect of their life and ministry. One cannot do anything about another's trustworthiness except, of course, pray for them but they can make sure with every fiber of their being that they are "fully applied" in their own life to being found trustworthy before the Father.
