#### THANKSGIVING IS A "SPIRITUAL FORCE"

### Words of prophecy:

\* "Thanksgiving" is a spiritual force, and the release of it - through an overflowing "heart of gratitude" towards Me - is a catalyst for the "erasure" of bad memories. For thanksgiving directed towards Me [and My Word - for all that He has DONE through the shedding of His precious Blood at Calvary] on a continual basis brings forth the "release" of My Goodness and Glory in one's life - the spontaneous fruit of this being to "supernaturally" replace that which the Enemy had established previously in their lives with a continually deeper revelation of the Reality of My Word [Truth] and My Kingdom - as well as a continually deeper revelation of the great Love [and approval] that I have for each and every one of My precious children.

"erasure" - to eliminate completely; obliterate; to remove or destroy all traces of;

The "spirit of thanksgiving" produces a continual "clarity" in one's heart.

"clarity" - clearness or lucidity as to perception or understanding; freedom from indistinctness or ambiguity [vagueness];

...."Be earnest and unwearied and steadfast in your prayer [life], being [both] alert and intent in [your praying] with thanksgiving".... Colossians 4:2 The Amplified Translation

...."He who offers a sacrifice of thanksgiving **honors Me**; And to him who orders [his] way [aright] I shall show the salvation of God".... Psalms 50:23 NASB

### **Prayer of Proclamation:**

Father, we thank You and praise You that as we are found abiding [dwelling] in a state of continual thanksgiving before You - for ALL that You, Jesus and the precious Holy Spirit have done [and continue to do] for us - great clarity [and the divine understanding that is its spontaneous fruit] is ours. And we declare it DONE [on an ongoing basis] in Jesus' Name - to Your greatest Glory. Amen.

**Note:** Clarity is one of the 4 chief characteristics of the Third Day anointing. The other 3 are: the impartation of godly zeal, holy fire [divine Light] and power [the impartation of Grace].
