BREAKING DOWN EVERY BARRIER OF UNBELIEF

Words of prophecy:

* If one "maintains" a root of mistrust in Me then it is certain that when the "storms" [pressures] come they will succumb to them - until such a time as they position themselves before Me in order that EVERY stronghold and vain [futile] imagination might be confronted by Me [2 Corinthians 10:3-5]. As one enters into the "inner chamber" [the secret place of My Presence] in this most critical hour I will SURELY break down every wall [barrier] of unbelief, and I will renew and strengthen their faith - that My Grace might enter into and flow in their life, replacing the very root of mistrust and fear that had held them down for so long [1 John 4:18]. In these days, perfect liberty [freedom] [2 Corinthians 3:17] on all fronts awaits the one who will truly forsake the desire to trust in their own understanding and strength [Proverbs 3:5-6].

"succumb" - to give way to superior force; yield; surrender;

.... "Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts on them, may be compared to a wise man who built his house on the rock. "And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and slammed against that house; and yet it did not fall, for it had been founded on the rock. "Everyone who hears these words of Mine and does not act on them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand. ...."For God sets Himself against the proud (the insolent, the overbearing, the disdainful, the presumptuous, the boastful) - [and He opposes, frustrates, and

defeats them], but gives Grace (favor, blessing) to the humble [those who depend wholly on Him through faith]. [Prov. 3:34.] Therefore humble yourselves [demote, lower yourselves in your own estimation] under the mighty hand of God, that in due time He may exalt you, Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully. [Ps. 55:22.] Be well balanced (temperate, sober of mind), be vigilant and cautious at all times; for that enemy of yours, the devil, roams around like a lion roaring [in fierce hunger], seeking someone to seize upon and devour. Withstand him; be firm in faith [against his onset - rooted, established, strong, immovable, and determined], knowing that the same (identical) sufferings are appointed to your brotherhood (the whole body of Christians) throughout the world. And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all Grace [Who imparts all blessing and favor], Who has called you to His [own] eternal glory in Christ Jesus, will Himself complete and make you what you ought to be, establish and ground you securely, and strengthen, and settle you".... 1 Peter 5:5-10 The Amplified Translation

"doubt" - to be uncertain about; consider questionable or unlikely; hesitate to believe; to mistrust; to fear or be apprehensive about; to be uncertain about something; to be undecided - causing a form of double-mindedness;

Doubt is not something that just "suddenly" arises in one's heart. It is the spontaneous by-product of a heart that is holding to *[maintaining]* unbelief *[darkness]* in some form - through fear and mistrust.

...."If any of you is deficient in wisdom, let him ask of the giving God [Who gives] to everyone liberally and ungrudgingly, without reproaching or faultfinding, and it will be given him. Only it must be in faith [trust] that he asks with no wavering [no hesitating, no doubting]. For the one who wavers [hesitates, doubts] is like the billowing surge out at sea that is blown hither and thither and tossed by the wind. For truly, let not such a person imagine that he will receive anything [he asks for] from the Lord, [For being as he is] a man of two minds [hesitating, dubious, irresolute], [he is] unstable and unreliable and uncertain about everything [he thinks, feels, decides]"...
