A PEOPLE WHO ARE FREE FROM DOUBT, MISTRUST AND FEAR

Words of prophecy:

* *A continued mistrust of My character and My Word "allows" a "spirit of skepticism" to continually work in the heart of the mistrusting [doubting] one.*

Scepticism" is the "doctrine" of the heart which is not "wholly" given to Me.

"skepticism" - a doubting or incredulous state of mind; a disbelieving attitude; *[in philosophy: the doctrine that absolute knowledge {truth} is unattainable and that all things must be continually questioned and doubted];*

....'The LORD your God who goes before you will Himself fight on your behalf, just as He did for you in Egypt before your eyes, and in the wilderness where you saw how the LORD your God carried you, just as a man carries his son, in all the way which you have walked until you came to this place.' But for all this, you did not trust the LORD your God".... Deuteronomy 1:30-32 NASB

Leaning upon one's own strength and understanding is NEVER a "necessity".

...."Lean on, trust in, and be confident in the Lord with ALL your heart and mind and do not rely [to ANY degree] on your own insight or understanding [sense-knowledge and perception]. In ALL your ways know, recognize, and acknowledge Him [through the continual accessing of His Grace], and He [the Spirit of Grace] will direct and make straight and plain your paths".... Proverbs 3:5-6 The Amplified Translation
