### Jesus Knew Who He Was

\* Nearly every miracle that Jesus performed was performed with the Father's words on Jesus' lips.

Jesus revealed the will of the Father.

"My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work" (John 4:34).

"I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me" (John 5:30).

"I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me" (John 6:38).

"For I do always those things that please him" (John 8:29).

What a picture of the Master! He had no personal ambitions, no personal ends to achieve. He was simply doing the will of His Father, unveiling the Father until He could say, "He that hath seen me hath seen the Father" (John 14:9).

The fewer worldly ambitions we have, the fewer worldly desires, the more fully the Father will unveil Himself to us.

His words on our lips will perform the same prodigies that His Words

performed on Jesus' lips.

Self-seeking limits a person.

The selfish man is a limited man.

He who lives in the Word and lets the Word live in him, who practices the Word and acts upon it, is the one who reveals the Father.

When we act upon the Word of God we unveil the Father.
