#### TRUE ENJOYMENT

### Words of prophecy:

\* As one acknowledges Me in ALL of their ways I will SURELY lead them into "the fullness" of enjoyment" [the fullness of joy in EVERY endeavor]. Many attempt to formulate their "own" enjoyment but truly I say to you, not only do their "efforts" fall far short of what I have for them, it leads them on a path that moves them further and further away from the intimate fellowship with Me that I so desire.

"enjoyment" - the condition of enjoying anything; pleasure or satisfaction, that which gives pleasure or keen satisfaction; fruition; happiness; delight;

...."Lean on, trust in, and be confident in the Lord with ALL your heart and mind and do not rely [to ANY degree] on your own insight or understanding [sense-knowledge and perception]. In ALL your ways know, recognize, and acknowledge Him [through the continual accessing of His Grace], and He [the Spirit of Grace] will direct and make straight and plain your paths".... Proverbs 3:5-6 The Amplified Translation

"commit" - to give in trust; to put into charge or keeping; to intrust; to consign; used with *to*, *unto*.

...."Trust in the LORD and do good; Dwell in the land and cultivate faithfulness. Delight yourself in the LORD; And He will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the LORD, trust also in Him, and He will do it".... Psalm 37:3-5 NASB

Enter [through intimacy with the Father and His Word in the "inner chamber] into the fullness of the joy within you [set before you] on a continual basis.

...."You will make known to me the path of life; In Your Presence is fullness of joy; In Your right hand there are pleasures forever".... Psalm 16:11 NASB

...."Looking away [from all that will distract] to Jesus, Who is the Leader and the Source of our faith [giving the first incentive for our belief] and is also its Finisher [bringing it to maturity and perfection]. He, for the joy [of obtaining the prize] that was set before Him, endured the cross, despising and ignoring the shame, and is now seated at the right hand of the throne of God".... Hebrews 12:2 The Amplified Translation

"If because of the sabbath [rest], you turn your foot from doing your OWN pleasure on My holy day, and call the sabbath a delight, the holy day of the LORD honorable, and honor it, desisting from your OWN ways, from seeking your OWN pleasure and speaking your OWN word, THEN you will take delight in the LORD, and I will make you ride [soar] on the heights of the earth [Ephesians 2:6]"....
