THE VISION OF THE PILOT

VISION: I saw a pilot sitting in the cockpit of a large and beautiful plane [747] capable of soaring at high altitudes - but I saw many "reluctant" passengers on board the plane.

The Father spoke to me and said:

The "pilot" represents my forerunners [true delegated authorities].

The "large and beautful plane capable of soaring at high altitudes" represents the Glorious Church [and the true Kingdom-ministries within her] - a Church that will be found abiding in the "high place" [both individually and corporately], seated at My right Hand, in Christ.

The "reluctant passengers" represent those in the church at large who remain somewhat "uncomfortable" in the high places - and, thus, they *[through fear and unbelief]* remain bound to the false security of "sense-knowledge" and perception".

"reluctant" - unwilling, disinclined; offering resistance or opposition; not eager;

"sense knowledge" - that which is perceived by what one feels, hears, sees or thinks based on their outward circumstances; that which is perceived [and expressed] through the soul [mind, will, emotions] - apart from "revelation" [the Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of wisdom and revelation];

...."And He [the Father] raised us up together with Him and made us sit down together [giving us joint seating with Him] in the heavenly sphere [by virtue of our being] in Christ Jesus [the Messiah, the Anointed One]".... Ephesians 2:6 The Amplified Translation

...."Therefore if you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth. For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God".... Colossians 3:1-3 NASB

...." we see that they [the Israelites] were not able to enter [into His rest], because of their unwillingness to adhere to and trust in and rely on God [unbelief had shut them out]".... [Num. 14:1-35]".... Hebrews 3:19 The Amplified Translation

...."Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief".... Hebrews 4:11 KJV

...."we walk by faith [in the reality of who Love {the Word of God} says we are, in Christ], not by sight [feelings, "sense knowledge" - that which is "perceived" through the five physical senses {soul and body - as opposed to one's spirit}] ".... 2 Corinthians 5:7 NASB

THEREFORE

...."we consider and look [speak] not to the things that are seen [the lower reality - that which is real to the five physical senses] but to the things that are unseen [through faith in the higher Reality of God's Word]; for the things that are visible are temporal (brief and fleeting) [subject to change], but the things that are invisible are deathless and everlasting [Eternal] ".... 2 Corinthians 4:18 The Amplified Translation
