

THE VISION OF ONE STANDING BEHIND A VEIL

VISION: I saw one standing "behind a veil" and, initially the veil was not only blocking out "light" but it also kept them in their struggles and the mind-sets that were established in darkness. Once the veil was lifted *[and removed completely]* I saw a pure vessel who had been trained "FAR BEYOND" what it had "seemed like" *[through sense knowledge and perception]* - up until that point.

"veil" - something hung up, or spread out, to intercept the view, and hide an object *[in this case, to block one's discernment]*;

"sense knowledge" - that which is perceived by what one feels, hears, sees or thinks based on their outward circumstances; that which is perceived *[and expressed]* through the soul *[mind, will, emotions]* - apart from "revelation" *[the Holy Spirit - Who is the Spirit of wisdom and revelation]*;

...."the love of Christ controls us.... therefore, FROM NOW ON we recognize [consider] NO ONE according to the flesh" [the mind of the senses, outward appearances].... 2 Corinthians 5:14-16 NASB

"consider" - to fix the mind on, with a view to a careful examination; to ponder; to study; to meditate on; to look at attentively; to observe; to have regard to; to take into view or account; to think; to regard; to view;

Latin: "considerare" - to consider, view attentively;

synonym: - to ponder; weigh; study; reflect or meditate on; contemplate; examine;

the Father spoke to me and said;

The "veil" is representative of the veil of darkness with which the Enemy seeks to keep my people "enslaved" to his lies. It is a "veil" of darkness that has been established through "wrong positioning" on their part.

...."the god of this world has blinded THE MINDS OF THE UNBELIEVING so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God".... 2 Corinthians 4:4 NASB

The fact that the veil was, ultimately, "lifted" is representative of the Light *[revelation]* of My Word rising in one's heart - causing the darkness of the Enemy's lies to "dissipate".

"dissipated" - to scatter in various directions; disperse; dispel;

...."the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, that shines brighter and brighter until the full day".... Proverbs 4:18 NASB

...."The entrance and unfolding of Your words [into one's heart {spirit}] give light [revelation]; their unfolding gives understanding [discernment and comprehension]".... Psalms 119:130 The Amplified Translation

The fact that they were able to see themselves as a "pure vessel" after the veil was lifted is representative of the great preparation *[by My Hand]* that had been going on in their life "behind the scenes" - through many years.

They did not realize how perfectly I had been preparing them all along and when the veil was "completely lifted" they marvelled at the revelation that they were trained and prepared FAR BEYOND what they had realized - up until that time.

...."Blessed are the pure in heart [those undefiled in spirit]: for they shall see [both know and understand] God".... Matthew 5:8 NASB

In this hour, vast numbers of My children are going to see the veil lifted completely from their lives and they will know *[come to a deep revelation of the spiritual reality]* that I had been faithful to My Word all along - even though they felt that they were "languishing" and "floundering" much of the time. The Devil NEVER wins!
