The greatest of the saints used to avoid as much as they could the company of men, and chose to live for God in seclusion. He, therefore, who seeks to reach that which is hidden and spiritual must, with Jesus, slip away from the crowd. No one can safely appear in public who does not enjoy seclusion. No one safely talks but the one who gladly listens and keeps silent. No one safely rules but the one who is glad to be subordinate. No one safely commands but the one who has learned well to obey. No one safely rejoices but the one who has the testimony of a good conscience within. Even the tranquility of the saints was full of the fear of God. Nor were they the less earnest and humble within themselves because they shone with great virtues and Grace.
