MEDITATIONS ON THE TRUE CHRISTIAN LIFE

...."This book of the law [the Word of God] shall not depart from [always be in] your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for THEN you will make your way prosperous, and THEN you will have success".... Joshua 1:8 NASB

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* The Christian is one who no longer seeks "their" justification in themselves, but in Jesus Christ alone. They know that God's Word in Jesus Christ pronounces them guilty, even when they do not feel their guilt, and God's Word in Jesus Christ pronounces them not guilty and righteous, even when they do not feel that they are righteous at all. The Christian no longer lives of themselves, by their own claims and their own justification, but by God's claims and God's justification. They live wholly by God's Word pronounced upon them, whether that word declares them guilty or innocent.
