## ["Reflections" Of The Father's Heart]

[July 6th]

\* Allowing the principle of "spiritual equilibrium" [*an abiding peace and rest*] to remain in effect [*regardless of outside circumstances*] positions the one doing so to obey with pin-point accuracy at all times. For entrance into My Presence with a view to "calming the storm" so to speak empowers one to "rise above" the storm to gain the necessary revelation that will restore their spiritual equilibrium - and, thus, in acting upon the revelation [*instruction*] received from the Holy Spirit do that which is best in any given situation. Also, this positioning [*in one allowing themselves to have their spiritual equilibrium restored*] makes it very much easier for one to bring EVERY thought captive to a revelation of My Word - again, with great precision.

**"equilibrium"** - a state of rest or balance [*in this case, the place wherein one's spirit and soul {mind, will, emotions} are "garrisoned about" {protected, defended} by the supernatural peace and joy of God, in faith*].
