* Believe - and keep on believing. Receive - and keep on receiving, ALL that I have prepared for you.

"believe" - to have confidence in the existence, or the reliability of something [in this case, through a supernatural revelation of God's Word];

"receive" - to take into one's possession through appropriation;

"appropriate" - to take to or for oneself;

Latin: "recipere" - regain, take back, bring back, carry back, recover; take to oneself;

...."In [supernatural] hope against [natural] hope he [Abraham] believed, so that he might become a father of many nations according to that which had been spoken, 'SO SHALL YOUR DESCENDANTS BE'. Without becoming weak in faith he contemplated his own body, now as good as dead since he was about a hundred years old, and the deadness of Sarah's womb; yet, with respect to the promise of God, he did not waver in unbelief but grew strong in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully assured that what God had promised, He was able also to perform".... Therefore I say to you, all things for which you pray and ask, believe [based on the finished work of the Cross, the Word of God and the Blood Covenant] that you have [already] received them, and
