

# EXHORTATIONS FROM THE FATHER

## ["Reflections" Of The Father's Heart]

[October 7th]

\* My people need to be quick to tell the Enemy to SHUT his mouth - right in the face of his lying and fear-filled thought and words! For is it not written, ALL unrighteousness shall shut its mouth" *[in the Presence of My Truth]*? If one persists in "listening" to the fear-filled lies and thoughts of the Enemy THEN it is certain that they will, in some way, be found "giving voice" to those words of darkness - thereby "allowing" him inroads into their lives.

If one is faithful to both resist the Enemy and, in diligently resisting him, refuse to "acknowledge" *[accept]* his lying thoughts and words in ANY way THEN it is certain that not only will he "flee", his schemes and tactics will be fully exposed - making the one who is faithful to rebuke him at every turn "fully aware" of his movements, at all times.

Indeed, as My children are faithful to "give voice" to the "revelative thoughts" of My Word proceeding forth from My Spirit *[through their spirit into their "mind" [the Mind of Christ] and out of the "abundance" in their heart proclaimed through their mouth]* THEN it is certain that, in the continual exercising of a steadfast faith and trust, the words that they speak shall SURELY come to pass in ways that are exceeding abundantly beyond all that they could have even imagined.
