TRUE ENCOURAGEMENT

Words of prophecy:

True *[divinely inspired]* encouragement is the impartation of My Grace and Love for the express purpose of empowering *[helping]* one to navigate on the "narrow path" - with a view to them fulfilling their precious destiny in Christ.
