A CHEERFUL AND GENEROUS HEART

Words of prophecy:

* I never set up any of the principles of divine prosperity [superabundance] and increase found in My Word based on covetousness and hardness of heart in My people. The entire system that I instituted through My Word - as in all things pertaining to the Kingdom and the Church - is based upon a perfect obedience - a perfect obedience that is both motivated and carried out by My love shed abroad in My children's hearts.

If I call any one of My children to give anything - at any given time - it is for this one purpose and this one purpose only: that they might continually sow the "necessary" seeds that I instruct them to sow - in order to bring them into a state of "continual increase" and My greatest blessing in their own life and ministry. This is in order that they might be a continually greater blessing to all those who cross their path, and continually meet the deepest "needs" of the people!

"perfect obedience" - the seeking after and gaining a revelation of God's Will and, THEN, carrying it out to fulfillment from beginning to end *[regardless of how long that may take]* in the unction and power of the Holy Spirit, alone.

"legalism" - strict adherence, or the principle of strict adherence, to law or prescription, especially to the letter rather than the S[s]pirit;

There is NEVER to be any "legalism" involved [any leaning upon one's "own" understanding] in this matter of "sowing and reaping" but, rather, simply an absolute faith and trust in the Father continually [from the position of a cheerful and generous heart] being exercised towards the various seeds that one sows coming to "full fruition" [the fullness of their Kingdom-potential].

In this hour, the Father is preparing our hearts to both receive and handle [properly] vast amounts of Kingdom-finances and resources that will, literally, turn the world upside down before we leave here. Indeed, we are all still practicing and learning "on the go" but WHAT A JOY IT IS - as we continue to exercise the faith and trust and patience that is necessary to see the FULLNESS of the Father's highest purposes come to pass in this final hour [both in our own lives and in the remnant Church, corporately, throughout the earth].
