THERE IS NO COMPETITION IN THE KINGDOM

Words of prophecy:

* *Self-exaltation is the root of all "competition".*

"compete" - to strive to outdo another for acknowledgment;

....For we are not bold to class or compare ourselves with some of those who commend themselves; but when they measure themselves by themselves and compare themselves with themselves, they are without understanding".... 2 Corinthians 10:12 NASB

There is no "competition" in the Kingdom way of living - and we are warned in the scriptures not to compare ourselves with others [*which is self-exaltive in nature*]. Seeing others through a "heart revelation" [*given by the Holy Spirit*] immediately takes one much higher spiritually-speaking and this allows them to see from a totally different perspective - the Father's.

...."we walk by faith [revelation], not by sight.... therefore, from now on we recognize no one according to the flesh; even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him in this way no longer".... 2 Corinthians 5:7,16 NASB

...."Do nothing from factional motives [through contentiousness, strife, selfishness, or for unworthy ends] or prompted by conceit and empty arrogance. Instead, in the true spirit of humility [lowliness of mind] let each regard the others as better than and superior to himself [thinking more highly of one another than

*you do of yourselves]. Let each of you esteem and look upon and be concerned for not [merely] his own interests, but also each for the interests of others"....
Philippians 2:3-4 The Amplified Translation*
