TRUST IS THE KEY TO THE FULLNESS OF FELLOWSHIP WITH THE FATHER AND HIS WORD

Words of prophecy:

* *It is in the exercising of trust [faith] that one's Love is shown to be true - for without an active trust [faith] in their heart there is no capacity for one to Love.*

"trust" - reliance on the integrity, strength, ability, surety, etc., of a person or thing; confidence; confident expectation of something; hope;
