UNBELIEF IS A THIEF

Words of prophecy:

- * Unbelief stops the flow of My Anointing for My Love is "repelled" by the forces of darkness when those forces are adhered to through an act of one's will.
- "unbelief" is the "belief" [trust] in any word or action that adheres itself to [relies upon and trusts in] anything or anyone less than the spiritual reality of God's Word [the lies of the Enemy, the wisdom of the world etc];
- "repel" to thrust back or away; to keep off or out; fail to mix with; to produce a feeling of aversion or distaste in (someone or something); to push aside; dismiss; to have no affinity for; turn away from or spurn; to exert an opposing force on (something);
- "adhere" to stay attached; stick fast; cleave; cling to; to be devoted in support or allegiance [in this case, to hold closely the lies and deceptions {wiles} of the Enemy in one's heart through unbelief];
-"Jesus went out from there and came into His hometown; and His disciples followed Him. When the Sabbath came, He began to teach in the synagogue; and the many listeners were astonished, saying, "Where did this man get these things, and what is this wisdom given to Him, and such miracles as these performed by His hands? "Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, and brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? Are not His sisters here with us?" And they took offense at Him. Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his hometown and among his own relatives and in his own household."

And He could do no miracle there except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them. And He wondered at their unbelief. And He was going around the villages teaching".... Mark 6:1-6 NASB

Unbelief is a thief.
