THE PURSUIT OF SELF-GLORY IS NEVER HONORABLE

Words of prophecy:

* *It is "folly" [foolishness] for one to seek the praises and the approval of men [flesh and blood] and the recognition that those who are seeking after their own self-glory constantly pursue. For, in reality, as one is obedient before Me in the Kingdom -whether their accomplishments are "seen" by others or not - ultimately, EVERY last ounce of faith, love and obedience that they have exercised will be seen [recognized] not only by all in their "sphere of existence" but will be a memorial [be remembered], forever.*

"sphere of existence" - is not only one's "physical" existence but also their "spiritual existence" - an existence that includes those they have met in the past [friend and foe alike] as well as those they have yet to meet, as they continue on the path to the "fullness" of their precious destiny, in Christ.

.... "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord [words and acts of Love], knowing that your toil [obedience] is not in vain in the Lord".... 1 Corinthians 15:58 NASB

The pursuit of self-glory is NEVER honorable [can NEVER honor God].

"glory" - the occasion of praise; excellency; brilliancy; splendor; the presence of the Divine Being; the manifestations of the divine nature and favor to the blessed in heaven; celestial honor; heaven.

"honorable" - worthy of honor; fit to be esteemed or regarded; estimable;

illustrious; worthy of respect; regarded with esteem; to be commended; consistent with honor or rectitude;

....*"searching for honor is not honorable [does NOT honor God]"....*
